<b>Endonuclease Activity (Nicking)</b> - A 50 µl reaction in NEBuffer 2 containing 1 µg of supercoiled PhiX174 DNA and a minimum of 50 units of DNA Polymerase I, Large (Klenow) Fragment incubated for 4 hours at 37°C results in <10% conversion to the nicked form as determined by agarose gel electrophoresis.	<b>Pass</b>
<b>Phosphatase Activity (pNPP)</b> - A 200 µl reaction in 1M Diethanolamine, pH 9.8, 0.5 mM MgCl <sub>2</sub> containing 2.5 mM <i>p</i> -Nitrophenyl Phosphate (pNPP) and a minimum of 100 units DNA Polymerase I, Large (Klenow) Fragment incubated for 4 hours at 37°C yields <0.0001 unit of alkaline phosphatase activity as determined by spectrophotometric analysis.	<b>Pass</b>
<b>Protein Purity Assay (SDS-PAGE)</b> - DNA Polymerase I, Large (Klenow) Fragment is ≥ 99% pure as determined by SDS-PAGE analysis using Coomassie Blue detection.	<b>Pass</b>
<b>qPCR DNA Contamination (<i>E. coli</i> Genomic)</b> - A minimum of 50 units of DNA Polymerase I, Large (Klenow) Fragment is screened for the presence of <i>E. coli</i> genomic DNA using SYBR® Green qPCR with primers specific for the <i>E. coli</i> 16S rRNA locus. Results are quantified using a standard curve generated from purified <i>E. coli</i> genomic DNA. The measured level of <i>E. coli</i> genomic DNA contamination is ≤ 1 <i>E. coli</i> genome.	<b>Pass</b>
<b>RNase Activity (Extended Digestion)</b> - A 10 µl reaction in NEBuffer 4 containing 40 ng of a 300 base single-stranded RNA and a minimum of 1 µl of DNA Polymerase I, Large (Klenow) Fragment is incubated at 37°C. After incubation for 16 hours, >90% of the substrate RNA remains intact as determined by gel electrophoresis using fluorescent detection.	<b>Pass</b>
