Assay Name/Specification (minimum release criteria)

Exonuclease Activity (Radioactivity Release) - A 50 µl reaction in CutSmart® Buffer containing 1 µg of a mixture of single and double-stranded [³H] *E. coli* DNA and a minimum of 200 units of TaqI-v2 incubated for 4 hours at 65°C releases <0.1% of the total radioactivity.

Functional Testing (15 minute Digest) - A 50 µl reaction in CutSmart® Buffer containing 1 µg of Lambda DNA and 1 µl of TaqI-v2 incubated for 15 minutes at 65°C results in complete digestion as determined by agarose gel electrophoresis.

Ligation and Recutting (Terminal Integrity) - After a 20-fold over-digestion of Lambda DNA with TaqI-v2, >95% of the DNA fragments can be ligated with T4 DNA ligase in 16 hours at 25°C. Of these ligated fragments, >95% can be recut with TaqI-v2.

Non-Specific DNase Activity (16 Hour) - A 50 µl reaction in CutSmart® Buffer containing 1 µg of Lambda DNA and a minimum of 200 units of TaqI-v2 incubated for 16 hours at 65°C results in a DNA pattern free of detectable nuclease degradation as determined by agarose gel electrophoresis.

Protein Purity Assay (SDS-PAGE) - TaqI-v2 is ≥ 95% pure as determined by SDS-PAGE analysis using Coomassie Blue detection.

RNase Activity (Extended Digestion) - A 10 µl reaction in NEBuffer 4 containing 40 ng of a 300 base single-stranded RNA and a minimum of 1 µl of TaqI-v2 is incubated at 37°C. After incubation for 16 hours, >90% of the substrate RNA remains intact as determined by gel electrophoresis using fluorescent detection.
